I. SUPPLIES NEEDED

- B. 2 inch 3 ring binder to allow insertion of numerous handouts, to include labs
- C. Periodic Chart – given in this packet
- D. Scientific Calculator
- E. 5 X 8 inch file cards – 3 per quarter, 6 per semester
- F. Composition notebook for warm ups!
(Bound notebook only - no spiral notebooks! No tearing out pages!)

II. CLASSROOM RULES
